zes from the E N E steering N W Lat 29.08 N

Remarks on Board Tuesday Apr 8th
The fore part of the day light breezes from the N E
saw a number of Finbacks The capⁿ lowered and shot
a bomb into one but did not see him after the
watch employed at various jobs the middle and latter
parts light breezes from the N E steering N W
Lat 30.44 N
Long 178.30 W

Remarks on Board Wednesday Apr 9th
The fore part of the day light breezes from the
N E the middle part much the same went down
the fore topgalant yard and mast the latter part
fresh breezes from the E N E steering N W
Lat 32.53 N
Long 178.42 W

Remarks on Board Thursday Apr 10th
The fore part of the day light breezes from the N
E and fog the middle part fresh breezes saw
a number of Finbacks the latter part strong breezes
and thick wet weather steering N W under easy
sail Lat 35.04 N
Long 179.30 E

The fore part of the day strong breezes from the
N the middle part fresh breezes kept the
ship off before the wind and set up the head
stays the latter part fresh breezes from the E
S E the ship close hauled on the starboard
tack heading N W Lat 36.18 N
Long 178.15 E

The fore part of the day strong breezes from the E
N E the middle part and latter part thick
squalls from the N E steering N W

the middle part more moderate put out a new Bow
Boat the latter part fresh breezes from the W the
ship close hauled on the Port tack heading S N W
Lat 40.25 N

Remarks on Board Wednesday Apr 16th
The fore part of the day light breezes from the S E
the middle part strong breezes and thick wet weather
the latter part fresh breezes from the S E W and
thick rainy weather steering N W

Remarks on Board Thursday Apr 17th
The fore part of the day fresh breezes from the E W
the middle part fog squalls the watch employed
breaking out squalls the latter part fresh breezes
from the E W saw a number of Finbacks and Hump
backs at sunset took in the light sails and luffed too

The fore part of the day strong breezes from the
E W the middle part much the same the latter
part a moderate gale from the S W the ship
laying too on the port tack heading W N W

The fore part of the day strong breezes from the W S W
set double reefed Topsails the middle part set the mainsail
and jib the latter part strong breezes from the W
at sunset shortened sail
