The fore part of the day fresh breezes from the N W a number of finbacks in sight the middle part calm the latter part light breezes from the S W steering N W

The fore part of the day light breezes from the S and thick fog the middle part the fog lit up a little we saw a number of Finbacks and Sulpherbottoms the latter part light breezes from the E S E steering N W

Remarks on Board Sunday May 18th

The fore part of the day fresh breezes from the S the land in sight we stood in within about three miles of it and tacked off the middle and latter parts fresh breezes from the N N E the ship close hauled heading E

Remarks on Board Monday May 19th
The fore part of the day fresh breezes from the N N E went down the main Topgalant yard to fish it and sent the fore Topgalant yard up in its place the middle part much the same large quantities of Sulpherbottoms in sight the latter part fresh breezes from the N E by N the ship heading E

The fore part of the day strong breezes from the N N E saw a shoal of Grampasses and a Sulpherbottom the middle and latter parts strong breezes from the S and thick wet weather laying too on the Port tack

The fore part of the day fresh breezes and thick fog the middle part light breezes saw a shoal of Killers and lowered the boats for them without success the latter part fresh breezes from the N E saw a number of Finbacks the ship on the Port tack heading E S E
