Remarks on Board Saturday July 26th

The fore part of the day a moderate gale from S S W hooked on and tried to cut our whale but he surged so heavy we was afraid of the main mast we set the Port side of the main riging and put on a large Tackle for a press enter then cut the lips and throat and cut the head part way off and broke a toggle and broke the chain to our throat toggle and lost it and then lashed down to wait for better weather it being so rugged it was like to tear things all to pieces the latter part a fresh gale from the S S W the ship laying on the port tack heading W
