The fore part of the day light breezes from the N^W saw a sail astern the middle part much the same the watch employed washing and drying bone saw a number of Finbacks and caught two Porpoises the latter part fresh breezes and rain squalls from the N^W steering E S E

The fore part of the day fresh breezes and rain squalls from the N^W the middle and latter parts much the same raised a sail two points on the starboard bow steering E S E

The fore part of the day fresh breezes and rain squalls from the N^W the middle part the same the watch employed washing ship saw one Finback the latter part fresh breezes from the N^W steering S E by E

Remarks on Board Tuesday Oct 21st
The fore part of the day light breezes from the N^W the middle part the same raised a large breack and ran for it it proved to be a Finback the watch employed at various jobs the latter part fresh breezes from the N^W steering S E by E

Remarks on Board Wednesday Oct 22nd
The fore part of the day light breezes from the N^W saw a shoal of Porpoises the middle part the same the watch employed washing ship the latter part fresh breezes from the N^W steering S E by E

Remarks on Board Thursday Oct 23rd
All this twentyfour hours fresh breezes from the N^W the watch employed at vary jobs saw one finback and raised a sail ahead (but did not get near enough to tell how she was steering) steering E by S

Remarks on Board Friday Oct 24th
All this Twentyfour hours fresh breezes from the N^W by W the watch employed mending the fore sail steering E

Remarks on Board Saturday Oct 25th
The fore part of the day light breezes from the N^W the middle part much the same the land in sight to the N E saw large numbers of Porpoises and a number of Finbacks the latter part light breezes from the N^W steering E caught a Porpois

Remarks on Board Sunday Oct 26th
The fore part of the day calm the land in sight all along the Eastern board the middle part light baffling winds the latter part light breezes from the N^W steering S

Remarks on Board Monday Oct 27th
The fore part of the day thick fog and calm elost in shore in 23 fathoms water the middle and latter parts light breezes from the N^W sent two boats in shore looking for turtle but did not see any after dark saw a steamer bound up the coast towards the N^W
