Remarks on Board Wednesday Mar 11th

All this twentyfour hours light baffling winds and calms about twelve o'clock got a pilot and tried to work up towards the harbor but did not get there about one o'clock there was another pilot came onboard and stayed over night

Remarks on Board Thursday Mar 12th

All this Twentyfour hours light breezes from the N. got in and came to an anchor in Hilo harbor about two o'clock P.M.

Remarks on Board Friday Mar 13th

The fore part of the day fine weather the Starboard watch on liberty the starboard watch employed at various jobs the latter part rainy

Remarks on Board Saturday Mar 14th

All this Twentyfour hours fine weather the Starboard watch on liberty the Port watch employed at various jobs painted the bends on the Port side Wm. Potter went on shore on the Doctors care

Remarks on Board Sunday Mar 15th

All this Twentyfour hours very changeable weather the Port watch on Liberty

on a Whaling Voyage in the Pacific in 1857
Hilo Harbor

Remarks on Board Monday Mar 16th

All this twentyfour hours fine pleasant weather the Starboard watch on Liberty the other watch employed getting water Discharged our two Bunaks

Remarks on Board Tuesday Mar 17th

The fore part of the day fine weather all hands employed getting off water and provisions the latter part of the day rainy

Remarks on Board Wednesday Mar 18th

The fore part of the day rainy the middle and latter parts fine weather the Port watch on liberty the Starboard watch employed at various jobs landed 20 bbls of fish

Remarks on Board Thursday Mar 19th

The fore part of the day fine weather the Starboard watch on liberty the Port watch employed at various jobs the middle and latter parts frequent rain squalls

Remarks on Board Friday Mar 20th

All this Twentyfour hours rainy Took a raft of cask ashore and filled them so rugged we could not get them off

Remarks on Board Saturday Mar 21st

All this Twentyfour hours fine pleasant weather Discharged Wm. Potter Sick and Patrie Priar came James Woods Disbursed set the collars for a Pilot he came on Board about sunset and hove short
