The fore part of the day strong breezes from the N and squalls the middle and latter parts fresh breezes from the S by W made all sail the watch employed at various jobs mended the mizen topsail steering W

All this twentyfour hours fresh breezes from the S E and E S E the watch employed at various jobs steering W

The fore part of the day fresh breezes from the E S E the middle part much the same the watch employed mending the spanker the latter part fresh breezes from the E steering W by S

The fore part of the day fresh breezes from the E S E the middle part the same the watch employed at various jobs the latter part fresh breezes from the S E steering S W by W (changed the day)

The fore part of the day fresh breezes from the S S E the middle part the same the watch employed all hands employed coopersing oil the latter part light baffling winds and calms and squalls of fog and rain steering or trying to steer S W by W
