Remarks on Board Saturday Aug 29th

The fore part of the day light breezes from the N^W S^E got underway and worked out of the bay the middle and latter parts fresh breezes from the N^W and S^E and rain the ship working to the Northward

Remarks on Board Sunday Aug 30th

The fore part of the day fresh breezes from the N^W the middle part calm saw two mustelidgers the latter part fresh breezes from the N^W the ship by the wind on the Port tack Capt. Hecox came on board from the Bark Warren

Remarks on Board Monday Aug 31st

The fore part of the day strong breezes from the N^W four ships in sight Round island in sight bearing about S^W by S the middle and latter parts light breezes from the N^W kept off E

Remarks on Board Tuesday Sep 1st

All this twentyfour hours light breezes from the N^W and S^W saw a shoal of Killers saw a sail in the S^E a long way off unbent the cables and stowed them below

Remarks on Board Wednesday Sep 2nd

All this twentyfour hours light baffling winds and calms saw a number of Finbacks and Humpbacks Bonas Island in sight bearing N^E by N steering or trying to steer E

Remarks on Board Thursday Sep 3rd

The fore part of the day calm the middle part the same saw a number of Finbacks the latter part light breezes from the N^W bent and set a topmast standing sail steering E by S

Remarks on Board Friday Sep 4th

The fore part of the day calm saw a number of Finbacks and a shoal of Grampasses the middle and latter parts light airs from the S^E and thick fog the ship by the wind on the Starboard tack N Obs

Remarks on Board Saturday Sep 5th

The fore part of the day light airs and thick fog from the N^E and S^E the middle and latter parts fresh breezes from the E and S^E saw a number of Finbacks the ship by the wind on the Starboard tack

Remarks on Board Sunday Sep 6th

The fore part of the day fresh breezes from the N^E the middle part much the same saw one Finback the latter part fresh breezes from the N^W steering E by S

The fore part of the day strong breezes from the N^W at day light kept off S^E the middle part the same the latter part light breezes from the N^W at dark kept off S^E all sail set
