Remarks on Board Sunday Oct 4th
All twentyfour hours light breezes from the N.W.
and N.E. saw whales and lowered for them but
without success four ships in sight at dark took
in sail Lat 51.33 N

Remarks on Board Monday Oct 5th
The fore part of the day a fresh breeze from the N.E.
made all sail and kept off S. The middle part the
same saw two or three whales going quick lowered without
success the latter part a fresh breeze from the E.N.E. the
ship by the wind on the Port tack three sails in sight
Lat 50.22 N
Long 153.30 E

Remarks on Board Tuesday Oct 6th
The fore part of the day fresh breezes and rain
from the N.E. got out clear of the fifty passage
the middle and latter parts strong breezes from
the N. and N.E. steering E by S six ships in
sight Lat 49.08 N
Long 174.33 E

Remarks on Board Wednesday Oct 7th
The fore part of the day strong breezes from the N.
the middle and latter part fresh breezes from the
N.W. and W. bent and set a main topgallant standing
sail steering E by N under all sail Lat 48.10 N
Long 163.30 E

Remarks on Board Thursday Oct 8th
The fore part of the day light breezes from
the W. the middle and latter parts strong
breezes from the S.W. split the main topgallant
sail sent it down and bent the fore topgallant
sail in place of it steering E. Lat 48.00 N

Remarks on Board Friday Oct 9th
The fore part of the day strong breezes from the S.W.
the middle part the same the latter part a moderate
gale from the E. the ship laying too under a
double reefed main topsail No Obs

Remarks on Board Saturday Oct 10th
The fore part of the day the wind shifted to the S.W.
and blowed a gale the middle part more moderate
kept off and made sail the latter part strong breezes
from the N.W. took in the bow boat steering E by S
Lat 48.08 N
Long 174.33 E

Remarks on Board Sunday Oct 11th
All this twentyfour hours fresh breezes and rain
squalls from the W. steering E by S under all sail
Lat 46.52 N
Long 179.30 E

Remarks on Board Monday Oct 12th
All this twentyfour hours moderate breezes and rain
squalls from the W. steering E by S under all sail
caught a Porpoise Lat 46.05 N
Long 176.10 W

W. the watch employed at various jobs steering E
under all sail Lat 45.18 N
