Remarks on Board Monday Nov 30th

The fore part of the day fresh breezes from the S S
& the middle part the same the watch employed
reparing the old fore topsail the latter part light
breezes from the E S E the ship by the wind on
the Port tack under all sail Lat 2.36 S
Long 152.40 W

Remarks on Board Tuesday Dec 1st

All this twentyfour hours moderate breezes from the
S E the watch employed at various jobs bent the
old fore topsail the ship by the wind under all sail
Lat 2.29 S
Long 152.00 W

Remarks on Board Wednesday Dec 2nd

All this twentyfour hours light breezes from
the S E and S E by E the watch employed
setting up rigging about three o'clock P.M. raised
Sperm whales spouting about two points forward
of the weather beam two miles or two miles and
a half off lowered the boats and pulled to
the windward about a mile then took our paddles
but the whales went to windward we did not
get near enough to see them from the boats at all
the ship by the wind on the Port tack under all
sail Lat 1.51 S

the ship by the wind on the Port tack under

Long 154.44 W

various jobs steering S E by S under all sail
Lat 8.25 S
Long 153.48 W

Remarks on Board Sunday Dec 6th

All this twentyfour hours fresh breezes from
the E S E and saw a sail at a distance, steering
S by E under all sail
Lat 10.44 S
Long 152.51 W

Remarks on Board Monday Dec 7th

All this twentyfour hours moderate breezes from the
S E and E S E the watch employed at various
jobs steering S by E under all sail
Lat 12.57 S
Long 152.47 W

at various jobs the ship by the wind on
