and calms the Starboard watch on Liberty

Remarks on Board Monday Mar 8th
All this twentyfour hours light breezes from the
S the Port watch on Liberty the Starboard watch
employed painting the spars

Remarks on Board Tuesday Mar 9th

The fore part of the day calm the middle part
much the same the Starboard watch on
Liberty the Port watch employed painting the
spars took a raft of cask ashore and filled
them with water the latter part strong
breezes from the S

on a whaling voyage in the Pacific in 58
Talcabano

Remarks on Board Wednesday Mar 10th
All this twentyfour hours strong breezes from
the S the Port watch on Liberty the Starboard
watch employed painting ship got a raft of
water discharged our five cruizers

Remarks on Board Thursday Mar 11th
All this twentyfour hours moderate breezes
from the S the Starboard watch on Liberty
the Port watch setting up shooks

Remarks on Board Friday Mar 12th

All this twentyfour hours strong breezes from the S
the Port watch on Liberty sold the Bark B. Comings
two Pipes of Bread and sold the Bark Helen Mar
about 170 bbls of cask

and calms the Starboard watch on Liberty the
Port watch painting ship
