Wednesday 14th
First part of these 24 hours strong breeze
from the W employed standing down at 6
PM finished Middle part steering S by E
Latter part a heavy from the W
Lat 46-05 S Long

Thursday Jan 15th
First part of these 24 hours a heavy gale from
the W heading to the W at sunset moderating
Middle part the same heading to the SSW Latter
part strong breeze and squally at 6 AM saw
a sperm whale hauled and struck and landed at
very late off-chasing

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Saturday 16th
First part of these 24 hours strong breeze
from the W heading off-chasing at 2 PM struck
a whale and got him at 4 PM got the whale along
side and got ready for cutting Middle part
the same Latter part more moderate at daylight
commenced cutting

from the W employed at cutting at 5 PM
Middle part employed at hailing the same
Latter part light breeze from the S heading
to the W employed at hailing
