First part of these 24 hours strong breeze
from the S heading to the W at 3 PM
fine bell standing down Middle part a gale
from the over W heading to the W Latter part
the same with rain

Friday Jan 23rd

First part of these 24 hours a gale from the W
and rain at 2 PM wind shifted to the S and
Moderate set double reef topsails at 5 PM
blowing a gale home the ship too much spence
Middle and Latter part the same

First part of these 24 hours a heavy gale
from the S W heading N by W Middle and
Latter part the same

the S heading to the S at 3 PM took in fore topsail
and fore sail Middle part the same Latter part
fresh gale and squally at 10 AM were ship to the

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from
the S W at 1 PM spoke the ship contest and became
a Rucker of New Bedford Middle part heading to
the over W Latter part at 10-30 tack to the S under
double reef topsails

load of coal Middle part head to the S Latter
calm and sail in sight

First part of these 24 hours light baffling wind
to the W Middle part the same Latter part light
wind from the over W and rain steering W by W
