

Remarks on board Bark-Lalla cruising in the South
Sunday March 24th

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from
the W heading to the E at 4 PM took in Mainsail
hike and foretop sail and hoisted up the Main
Middle part more moderate latter part light
breeze heading to the E under all sail.

Lat 38-51 S Long 52-23 W

Monday March 30th

First part of these 24 hours light breeze
from the E at 1 PM tack to the W at
2-30 wind hauled to the W tack to the
E Middle part under double reefed latter
part the same under all sail and fine
weather.

Lat 38-43 S Long

Tuesday March 31st

First part of these 24 hours moderate breeze
from the W heading to the E under all
sail Middle part wind W or W wore & bit
to the W latter part wind W or W heading
to the E.

Lat 38-16 S Long 51-32

Wednesday Apr 1st

First part of these 24 hours steady breeze
from the E heading to the S Middle
and latter part the same.

Lat 37-43 S Long

Thursday Apr 2nd

First part of these 24 hours moderate breeze from
the E heading to the E at 4 PM wind hauled to
the E tacked to the W Middle part the same latter
part light breeze heading W or W.

Lat 37-16 S Long 52-25

Friday Apr 3rd

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from
the E heading to the W at 3 PM wind hauled to
the S in a squall & steer W Middle part strong
breeze latter part moderate breeze from the S
steering W at 11 PM had a heavy squall which
hauled about 1 hour and sail in sight.

Lat 35-43 S Long 50-48

Saturday Apr 4th

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze
from the W S W and heavy squalls have to
under short sail heading to the E Middle
part the same latter part strong breeze and
clear weather & steering E by E under double reef.

Lat 35-10 S Long 51-10

Sunday Apr 5th

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze
from the S steering E by E under double reef
Middle and latter part moderate breeze from
the W S W course the same.

Lat 33-30 S Long 47-54 W

Monday Apr 6th

First part of these 24 hours moderate breeze from
the W S W steering S by E Middle wind hauling
to the E head to the E Middle latter part strong breeze
from the E heading W by W at 10 PM squally
double reef the top sail.

Lat 32-08 Long 47-48 W

Tuesday Apr 7th

First part of these 24 hours wind E heading
to the E Middle part wind W steering
W by E latter part a heavy gale from the W
steering W by E at 10 PM have the ship too
under bare poles to the E W.
