First part of the 24 hours a heavy gale from the
W & W heading to the NW Middle part the same
Leather part at 2 AM gale moderating at 6 AM
Star & by E wind continuing to the W
Lat 30-47 S Long

Thursday Apr 9th

First part of the 24 hours strong gale
from the W & W steering E by W under double
reef tape sail Middle part the same Leather
part Moderate Breezes from the S W under
all sail

First part of the 24 hours Moderate Breezes
from the S & steering E by E Middle part calm
Leather part light Breeze from the W & steering
E by E under all sail

First part of the 24 hours light Breezes from
the W & heading to the E by E at 10 AM hoisted a
Spanish rig 40 days from Cadix Banner to Monte
Lima Middle part light Breezes from the W & E
Leather part the same

Tuesday Apr 14th

First part of the 24 hours light Breeze from
the W & heading to the E by E at 4 PM hoisted the bark
rig of Spanish rig 4 days from Monte Lema
Banner to Liverpool Middle part light Breezes
from the W & heading E by E Leather part strong
Breezes Star & E at 10 AM raised Sperm Whale
going to the windward working the ship to the
windward for the Whale

Wednesday Apr 15th

First part strong winds employed working the ship
to the windward at 2 PM. O. C. E. moved away the boat
and pulled to the windward whales going quick to the
W by E. at 6 PM. O. C. E. came on board. Middle part light
winds. Latter part Moderate winds from the W & W
Made all sail stem to the O. C. E. at 10 PM. O. C. E. arrived
against Sperm Whales at 1 AM. moved away the Boat
and pulled to the windward in pursuit of ends
