Thursday May 7th

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes
and squalls from the E heading to the E
at sundown took in sail Middle Middle
part rain and wind shifted to the W head
to the E latter part fresh breezes and clear
from the S W at 10 PM were ship to the S

Friday May 8th

First part of these 24 hours fresh breezes
from the W S W heading to the S under
double reef to sails at sundown took in
sail Middle part the same latter part light breezes
under all sail

the same latter part at 4 PM took in light breezes
from the E S E strong breezes and squalls
took to the W and double reefed the top sails

at 6 PM

the W and thunder squalls put the ship under
sailing sail at 4 PM were ship to the W S W Middle
part a gale from the W S W ship heading W W
saw a schooner heading to the S

First part of these 24 hours moderate breezes
from the S heading to the S E under all sail
Middle part calm latter part at 4 PM took in
breeze from E S E set S E by S at sundown
took in sail Middle

W S W heading S E by S at sundown took in sail Middle
part increasing wind and heavy squalls latter part
a gale heading E

hauling to the W under Middle part moderating set
double reef Main top sail latter part increasing
