

Remarks on Board "Bark" Atlantic Ocean
Wednesday. Nov 10th

First part of the day 24 hours strong winds from the N. with heavy rain or snow.

Thursday 11th

First part moderate winds and fine weather. employed setting up shacks and rafting Casks on shore.

Friday 12th

First part pleasant weather and calm employed breaking out and setting up shacks.

Saturday 13th

First part light winds and fine weather. employed storing down Bales for fresh water and sending a raft of Casks on shore.

Sunday 14th

First part light winds and fine weather. on watch on shore.

Monday 15th

First part moderate winds from the South attended with rain or snow.

Tuesday 16th

First part pleasant weather and fine employed setting up shacks. or ends.

Wednesday 17th

First part pleasant weather. employed repairing the head of the Foremast. and other ship duties.

Thursday 18th

First part moderate winds and fine weather employed on the Foremast. or ends.

Friday 19th

First part fine weather all hands employed in various duties.

Saturday 20th

First part fine weather finished the Foremast and commenced setting up the rigging or ends.

Sunday 21st

First part strong winds from the S.W. and cloudy weather. the sailors watch on shore at sunset. all came on board.

Monday 22nd

First part pleasant weather employed in the fore rigging and other ship duties. brought off one raft of fresh water.

Tuesday 23rd

First part fine weather employed storing down water and working in the rigging or ends.

Wednesday 24th

First part moderate winds and fine weather storing down water. brought off two rafts of water from the fore rigging.

Thursday 25th

First part moderate winds from the S. employed storing water. and running other duties.

Friday 26th

First part fine weather all hands employed storing down water and working the ship.

Saturday 27th

First part mild weather. employed storing down water. brought another raft of water on board. also wood.

Sunday 28th

This day begins with moderate winds and fine weather. the foremast watch on shore. all came on board but Wm. H. Heath and a Spaniard.

Monday 29th

First part moderate winds and fine employed bringing off water and storing down or ends. Wm. H. Heath and the Spaniard still absent.
