

Remarks On board, Buss Callas South Atlantic
Tuesday, June 30th.

Sunday 5th

First part light winds and fine weather. all hands on board.

Monday 6th

First part light air and fine weather. all hands employed in ships duty.

Tuesday 7th

First part strong gale from the S.W. attended with much rain. & ends.

Wednesday 8th

This day begins with moderate winds from the Southward and fine weather. employed in various duties.

Thursday 9th

This day begins with light winds from the N. E. & fine. here up on Anchor. Saw 2 Mon in shore all hands employed as usual. & ends.

Friday 10th

This day begins with pleasant weather and moderate winds from the S.W. employed in various duties.

Saturday 11th

This day begins with light winds from the Southward and fine weather. employed in ships duty. Capt. Howland. Caught the Deuts 104 & Beath and brought him on board.

Sunday 12th

First part strong winds from the Southward & of Westward accompanied with rain at 1 P.M. dropped the Port Anchor. wind on the increase blowing a gale. & ends.

Monday 13th

First part moderate winds from the S.W. and fine weather employed in ships duty. Larboard watch on liberty & ends.

Tuesday 14th

First part light winds from the S.W. employed in various duties. Larboard watch on liberty at sunset. Came on board and brought with them 2 others. spaniards the Deutser much pleased to get on board. after an absence of 20 days.

Wednesday 15th

This day begins with moderate winds and fine weather. all hands employed in various duties. have deserted the ship.

Thursday 16th

First part moderate winds and fine weather. the W. O. Steamer "Whitman" came to anchor. the above men have taken the ship.
