W by S latter part fresh breeze from
the E steering W & W

steering W by W one sail in sight

First part of these 24 hours light breeze
from the E steering S W Middle part calm
latter part light baffling wind and rain steering
S W by W one sail in sight

Tuesday Sept 29th

First part of these 24 hours light breeze from
the E steering S W at 2 PM wind shifted to
the S heading to the S E Middle part at 11 AM
increasing wind latter part a gale at 8 AM
one sail to the E W Manuel Canas off duty sick with
fever

Wednesday Sept 30th

First part of these 24 hours a gale from the
S heading to the W Middle part Moderate
breeze from the S at daylight moderate breeze and
fine weather at 8 AM tacked to the S E at
10 AM fresh breeze double reef the top sail
caught a turtle

Lat 33-11 S Long 48-05 W

Thursday Oct 1st

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze
from the W heading to the S W under double
reef top sail and courses Middle part calm
latter part light baffling wind from various
points heading to the S W employed at
mending chain sail at noon rain

Friday Sept 2nd

First part of these 24 hours light breeze from the
S E and rain heading to the S W Middle and latter
part the same employed at mending a spare fore
top sail saw a bark steering W
