First part of these 24 hours Moderate breeze  
from the S heading to the W Middle part  
part of strong breeze under double reef  
at 7 PM spoke the Bark Adachank of Green  
Bedford

Sunday Oct 4<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from  
the S heading to the W under double reef  
Middle part Moderate latter part calm and bark  
in sight

Lat 35-06 Long 51-12  
Monday Oct 5<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hours calm and sail in  
sight Middle part light breeze from the  
W steering S W by S latter part the same  
employed at hauling

Lat 36-12 Long 52-07  
Tuesday Oct 6<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hours Moderate breeze  
from the W at 1 PM jumped and got bottom  
in 30 fathoms of water led by the wind to the  
W W at 4-50 PM saw Right whale to the  
windward Middle part under short sail latter  
part at 7 PM saw Whales at 7-30 under and  
struck and lost line 9 under again and galled  
at 10-00 under and struck at noon the boats  
off and fast

Lat 35-45 Long 53-00  
Wednesday Oct 7<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hours light breeze from  
the W at 1 PM took the Whale alongside and got  
ready for cutting at 3 PM commenced cutting at  
6 PM back up for the night Middle part employed  
at clearing away the head latter part at daylight  
commenced cutting again at 7 finished and got  
ready for hoisting calm and thick fog

Friday Oct 9<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from  
the S heading to the W employed at hauling  
Middle part Moderate latter part light breeze  
and clear at 9 AM finished hauling and commenced  
standing under

Lat 35-06 Long 50-45  
Saturday Oct 10<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hours light breeze from  
the S employed at standing under at 7 PM  
boarded the Ship George S. Susan Middle part light  
breeze from the W steering S W latter part light  
breeze from the S heading to the W employed  
at standing under at noon finished several cables  
in sight

Lat 36-46 Long 52-50  
Sunday Oct 11<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hours light breeze from  
the S heading to the W employed at breaking  
out for shade Middle and latter part light  
battering wind heading W by S saw two Whales  
sailing to the windward two sail in sight

Lat 35-31 Long 53-10  
Monday Oct 12<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hours Moderate breeze from  
the S heading on different tack at 4 PM under  
for Whales without success Middle part the same  
latter part light breeze and calm plenty of  
bumpback in sight 35 fathoms of water
