

Remarks on board *Barbados* South Atlantic
Saturday, October 24th

First part bright & variable winds on different locks employed boiling 3 sails in sight saw several Right Whales going quick to the windward, at 6 P.M. (Shoal) sail and main ship heading S. by E. Middle part the same with rain cooled down the works. latter part. more moderate & wanted the works. at 10.00. strong winds from the S.W. cooled down the works again and took in all sail wind still in the increase accompanied with some little rain

Sunday, October 25th

First part blowing a strong Gale from the S.W. heading S.E. at 3 P.M. the increase at 5 P.M. saw ship heading W. by N. under. Main Spencer & Foremast staysail. Middle part the same. latter part. Moderating & heading to the N. & W.

Monday, Oct 26th

First part Moderate Gale from the S.W. heading to the N.W. under. Main Spencer & Foremast staysail at 2 P.M. saw ship heading S.E. & started the works & Commenced boiling. Nothing in sight Middle part the same. latter part. More Moderate from the S.W. with a heavy swell. employed boiling & under

Tuesday, October 27th

First part Moderate Gale from the S.W. and heavy swell heading to the West employed boiling at 6 P.M. saw ship heading to the S.E. Middle part the same. at 8.0. 0.00 P.M. finished boiling latter part. moderate winds from the N.W. on different locks employed & storming down oil

Wednesday, October 28th

First part moderate winds from the N.W. on different locks employed storming down at 4 P.M. took the *His & Ours*. Middle part the same. latter part strong winds and variable on different locks the ship in sight

Thursday, October 29th

First part strong & variable winds attended with squalls. employed in various duties. on different locks at sunset shortened sail for the night in the Western tack. Middle part the same. latter moderate winds from the S.W. made all sail at 10.0. 0.00 am under the foretop sail & handed the course. blowing strong and sail in sight

First part strong Gale from the S.W. under close reefed main topsail heading W. at 10. at 5.0. 0.00 P.M. set double reefed on Main topsails and course. Middle part the same. latter part more moderate made sail two sails in sight

Saturday, October 31st

First part strong winds from the S.W. heading to the W. N.W. at 10.0. 0.00 P.M. saw ship heading S. by E. under. wind in the increase double reefed the topsails & finished the course. at 4 P.M. finished the foretop sail and close reefed the main sail blown a strong Gale from the South West. Middle part more moderate. latter part. set double reefed topsails and course. wind from the S.W. heading S.E. for sails in sight at 11 am. finished the course.

First part blowing a strong Gale from the S.W. under double reefed topsails heading to the S.E. at 3 P.M. close reefed the foretop sail at 6 P.M. finished foretop sail & close reefed the main topsail & saw ship heading W. by N. Middle part the same. latter part. More Moderate. saw ship at 8 am. heading S.E. by E. set double reefed topsails and course.
