

Remarks Onboard Ship Colles Atlantic
Saturday November 21st

First part strong wind from the South with heavy snow employed cutting the Whales at 1 O'Clock P.M. finished cutting at 4 o'clock. Sailed at 3 P.M. spoke the Buckle Island of Sag Harbor. 4 whales then sailed in sight 65 fathoms water. Middle part the same. Latter part light & pleasant wind from the N.W., steering to the S.W., at 10 AM saw Whales coming and gave chase. then sailed in sight. Latitude 38.04 Longitude 55.14

Sunday November 22nd

First part light winds from the N.W. and fine weather. Boat down chasing Whales. employed boring & pulling up Pipe Hooks at 3 P.M. boats came on board. Whales going quick to the South. Middle part the same. Latter part strong winds from the N.W. with misty weather. employed boring. Two sails in sight at 10 AM. looked for Whales going quick to the N.W. came on board at 11 AM. Latitude 38.26 Longitude 55.18

Monday November 23rd

First part strong winds from the N.W. steering by the wind to the N.W. employed boring & pulling up Hooks. One sail in sight boring. Middle part 9 P.M. finished boring. Latter part light air and Calms. employed showing down. 2 sails in sight. One boring. Three days November 24th

First part light air & Calms. with fine weather employed showing down. at 5 P.M. looked for Whales. without success going quick to the Westward. Middle part Moderate breeze from the N. Latter part strong wind under short sail. finished showing down. Latitude 37.56 Longitude 55.45

Tuesday November 25th

First part strong winds from the N. and fine. steering S by W. employed scraping down & clearing up decks. at 10 AM shortened sail for the night 45 fathoms water. took out for provisions. Middle part the same. Latter part light winds from the S.W. heading W.N.W. employed in the fore. at 9 AM spoke the Alwachonts. Latitude 38.38 Longitude 55.52

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Wednesday November 26th

First part light winds from the S.W. and fine weather. standing to the W. in company with the Alwachonts employed working on the Board 45 fathoms water. Middle part the same. Latter part light winds from the West. with wind to the Southward. Under double reefed topsails. One ship in sight. Latitude 38.05 Longitude 55.21

Thursday November 27th

First part light winds from the West. and beautiful weather. standing to the South under easy sail at 6 O'Clock P.M. was ship heading to the West. Middle part the same. Latter part light air & Calms. with fine weather. One sail in sight. Latitude 38.10 Longitude 55.47

Friday November 28th

First part of the day strong N.W. winds and clear weather. steering S by E under all sail. 55 fathoms water. Middle part the same. Latter part Moderate winds from the N. & fine weather. heading S by S. under all sail. two sails in sight. Latitude 38.28

Saturday November 29th

First part moderate wind from the N.W. & fine weather steering S.S.E. under all sail at 4 P.M. spoke. Bark Alwachonts & River at sunset shortened sail for the night & hauled on the wind heading to the N.W. Middle part the same. Latter part light air & Calms. with squalls. One sail in sight. Monday November 30th

First part light & variable winds with frequent rain & squalls. Middle part wind from the S.W. with much rain. Latter part light winds from the same quarter. heading S by S. at 11 AM one ship heading West. one sail in sight. Latitude 38.28 Longitude 55.14
