

Remarks on board, Barge, Callao, South Atlantic
Friday Mch 18th

First part moderate winds & heavy snow employed working ship to the N.E. in pursuit of whales. at 3 PM. saw two whales on the horizon. coming away 1 Boats and one crew. at 5 PM came on board. saw one of eight to the windward. at 6 PM the *De la Brea* Captain Gilder then ships in sight. Midday part light breeze from the N.E. heading S.E. under 3 sails & courses. latter part light & pleasant winds from the E. Made sail of one ship heading N.W. & two sails in sight

Monday Mch 21st

First part moderate Gale from the E. & squalls with rain at 2 PM fresh. fore courses & one ship heading S.E. one sail in sight. midday part the same. latter part moderate Gale from the E.N.E. and rain with squalls heading S.E. under double reefed Main topsail & fore courses
