

Remarks on board 1 Bark Callas. South Atlantic
Saturday Mch. 26th

Fine fair light & pleasant breeze from the S.E. with fine
weather clearing. M.W. under full sail. Watch employed
in ship duty. Middle part the same latter part
wind from the N.E. & light in the wind to the N.W. at 6 P.M.
Am sighted the land ahead employed in various duties

Latitude 27.49
Longitude 47.47

Sunday Mch 27th

Fine fair. wind from N.E. & light with pleasant
weather. on the going to the N.W. employed in various duties
4 sails in sight. Boat Cidley at 5.0. CLK P.M. some
ship heading S.E. Middle part light & variable winds
working to the Windward. Latter part light winds &
variable employed working ship to the N.W. Clear.

Monday Mch 28th

Fine fair light & variable winds employed working
ship to the N.W. for the passage. at 3 P.M. fine N.E. breeze
clearing in the passage at sunset. at 9.0. CLK P.M. came
to anchor in 10 fathoms water. Middle part. Much
rain latter part. Plenty rain at 8 A.M. boat anchor
& commenced towing the ship at 9. boats came
alongside & made sail on the ship working up to the
anchorage at 10. A.M. came to anchor at 11. wind died
away.

Tuesday March 29th

Fine fair calm & rain at anchor below the port at 2 P.M.
sailed away. Boats commenced towing with a light breeze
from the N.E. at 3 P.M. came to anchor in 10 fathoms water. about
the port. Middle part much rain latter part pleasant
weather. Capt. Hornland. goes to the ship.

selling up foremast & rigging

Saturday April 2nd

Fine fair. pleasant weather set up foremast & rigging
Mast & set up the rigging make up for. Dues confirmed

Sunday April 3rd

This day fine weather and light N.E. winds working
boats on shore.

Monday April 4th

This day fine weather employed in ship duty. Shoreboard
Watch on liberty

Tuesday April 5th

Fine fair fine weather employed breaking out oil
Shoreboard Watch on liberty

Wednesday April 6th

This day strong S.W. winds and rain. Shoreboard Watch
on liberty

Thursday April 7th

This day strong S.W. winds employed breaking
out and filling bbls with oil. John Cough has
been absent from ship. Forty eight boxes. and notes
are despatched
