Monday May 2nd
This day began with fine weather & Calm. at anchor. Waiting
for a breeze to spring up.

Tuesday May 3rd
This day began with fine weather. Pleasant winds from
the N.W. at anchor. Waiting out. at 4 P.M. all clear
of the land. Middle part slightly shrouded sail latter
part strong winds from the S.W. shrouding S.E. Under
double reefed topsails & mizen. one sail in sight

Wednesday May 4th
This day. Slightly weathered & strong winds from the
N.W. shrouding to the S.E. under all standing sail middle
part the same. Latter part strong winds from the Westward
shrouding S.E. under double reefed topsails & mizen
employed in various duties

Thursday May 5th
This day fine weather. Strong winds from the W. shrouding
S.E. under. whole topsails & mizen. Middle part slightly
weather. Latter part strong winds & rain. Middle part
slightly. Employed selling up food & stows

Friday May 6th

This day. Strong westerly winds. At anchor with rain and
heavy squalls. shrouding S.E. under double reefed topsails
and mizen at sunset clear reefed main top sail and
brought the ship to the wind heading S.W. Middle part the
same. Latter part moderate winds from the W. & fine weather
shrouding S.E. under all sail

Saturday May 7th
This day moderate winds from the W. & fine weather shrouding
to the S.E. at 4 P.M. on the wing to the S.W. at sunset
brought sail and wind ship heading to the N.W. Middle
part the same. Latter part Calm. employed with rigging

Sunday May 8th
This day fine weather. Light air from the N.W. heading
to the W. S.W. under all sail at sunset took in sail for
the night middle part the same. Latter part light & variable
winds with abundance of rain under all sail

& fine weather. shrouding to the East under all sail at
