

Remarks on board Captain Callas South Atlantic
Tuesday May 31st West

This day fine weather & fine pleasant wind from the N.E.
Heading N. employed in ships duty. Middle & latter parts same
Wind S.W. during N.W.

Wednesday June 1st Latitude 14.53
Longitude 3.22

This day fine weather and pleasant wind from the S.W.
steering N.W. under full sail at sundown shortening sail
middle part the same. latter part moderate winds from the
S.E. & fine weather steering N.W. under full sail

Latitude 16.34
Longitude 4.40

Thursday June 2nd

This day light S.E. trade winds & fine weather steering
N.W. under full sail at 4th P.M. saw the land Island
of St Helena distant about 14 miles Middle part
generally weather & rain. Sailed up on the Eastern track
latter part moderate winds & rain with much rain & some
light fog at 10. light breeze steering for the Harbor. Overboard.

Friday June 3rd

This day fine weather & light S.E. trade winds. Breeze &
Capt Monlanq went in shore. Middle part all the same
latter part strong S.E. trade winds off E.W.

Saturday June 4th

This day fine weather & strong trade winds off E.W.
at 4 P.M. Capt Monlanq came on board ready for sea. On the
wing to the N.E. under reefed topsails. Middle part the
same. latter part pleasant wind from the S.E. and fine
weather. On different tracks. Land in sight

Sunday June 5th

This day pleasant S.E. trade winds. On different
tracks steering off to the land. Middle & latter parts
the same. No sails in sight land from 10 to 20 miles
distant.

Monday June 6th

This day fine S.E. trade winds & pleasant weather. On different
tracks land from 10 to 20 miles distant. Same gentle
in number of sails. Middle part the same. latter part
moderate S.E. trade winds & fine weather. Land in sight
overboard this day

Tuesday June 7th

This day fine weather & light S.E. trade winds on different tracks
land in sight distant about 20 miles. Same gentle in number
of sails. Middle & latter parts much
the same steering on the Southern track.

Wednesday June 8th

This day fine weather & light trade winds on the Southern
track under full sail at 6 P.M. then ship heading to
the N.E. Nothing in sight Middle & latter parts much
the same. on various tracks land in sight about 20 miles distant

Thursday June 9th

This day fine weather & light S.E. trade winds. Steaming to the
Southern track under full sail. No sails in sight. also land about
20 miles distant. Middle & latter parts light air from the South
heading to the E. under full sail.

Friday June 10th

This day light air & calm. employed in various duties at 4
O.C.K. P.M. sent down the Main top sail & sent another Middle
and latter parts much the same.

Saturday June 11th

This day light winds from the S.E. & fine weather off
and on the land. Sixteen sails in sight land about
15 miles distant. Middle & latter parts light S.E. trades
land in sight. Overboard
