 Sunday August 2nd

This day, light winds & fine weather heading West
 Watch employed, painting ship inside middle part
 the same. latter part light air from the East & fine
 weather. land in sight. distant about 60 miles. Watch
 employed. painting ship inside

This day, fine weather & light winds heading to the S.
 under easy sail. Watch employed painting ship
 middle part the same. latter part light air & fine
 weather. under easy sail heading towards the land.
 Watch employed in various duties

This day, light air & fine weather. Watch employed
 in various duties. land in sight at 5 1/2 PM. traced
 the yards. heading off the land. Middle part calm
 latter part calm & clear weather. low sail in sight.
 As. ends this day.

This day light air & calm. Watch employed in
 various duties land distant about thirty fine miles
 Watch busily occupied with ship duty. Middle part
 the same. latter part moderate trades & fine weather
 on different tacks. low sail in sight

Thursday August 6th

This day, strong trades & fine weather on different
 tacks. Watch busily occupied with ship duty. low sail
 in sight. shortened sail for the night. on the Eastern tacks
 land distant about 10 miles. Middle part the same latter
 part strong trades. at 5 1/2 AM. ship heading in
 show. strong and cloudy.

Friday August 7th

This day, strong trades under & squally weather. Standing
 in towards the land at 4 PM. came to anchor in the harbor
 of St. Helena. We did not see the same. latter part. at
 anchor. Harbour. Watch on duty

Saturday August 8th

This day strong winds & squally with rain. employed
 breaking out provisions & stowing other holds

Sunday August 9th

This day pleasant weather & moderate trade winds.
 Watch busily employed, at 12 PM. the ship's company
 in getting underweigh got a foul of us & came away
 the jibboom split the end of the first jibboom. Watch
 employed clearing away the wreck. got off our reef.
 Water containing 14 Casks.

Monday August 10th

This day fine weather. Employed getting off the water
 and showing it away. Carpenter employed, making new
 fly jibboom

Tuesday August 11th

This day fine weather. got off the water. Watch &
 showed it down. making 250 lbs. finished the spar and
 set it out

Wednesday August 12th

This day fine weather. Employed rigging the jibboom
 Baller duties. Harbour. Watch on duty
