Topsail

This day begins with a moderate Gale from the S.W. heading S.E. under Double reefed M. Topsail. thick hazy weather at 6 P.M. clear reefed the M. Topsail. wind on the increase. middle part wind from the West heading South. latter part strong Gale from the West & attended with heavy rain squalls heading S.W. under clear reefed M. Topsail. one sail in sight
