This first part strong winds from the S.W. & clear weather on different tacks 50 fathoms water. 4 sails in sight at sunset shortened sail for the night. spoke the Pique John A. Rabb. Stairing of Sag Harbor nothing this season. Middle part the same. latter part moderate winds from the N.E. & clear weather on different tacks 3 sails in sight 50 fathoms water.

Saturday October 1st

This day strong winds from the N.E. & clear weather on different tacks. at 1 P.M. double reefed the topsails. wore ship heading to the E.S.E. wind hauling to the S.W. sounded 4 fathoms 50 fathoms water. 3 sails in sight spoke the Callas Stairing of Sag Harbor nothing this season. middle part the same. latter part light & variable winds on different tacks under all sail.

This day moderate winds from the S.W. & clear weather on different tacks under easy sail. Saw one Right Whale going quick 50 fathoms water. at sunset shortened sail 2 sails in sight. Middle part the same. latter part light wind and calm. 4 sails in sight 50 fathoms water.

Thursday October 6th

This day begins with a calm & clear weather. 4 sails in sight. at 4 P.M. O.C.R. saw light breeze spring up from the S.E. heading on the Southern tack at sunset took in the light sails & double reefed the topsails 50 fathoms water. Middle part the same. latter part strong winds from the S.E. and fine weather shift on different tacks. spoke the P. "Prace" Lawrence of New Bedford. Nothing this season. 3 sails in sight 50 fathoms water.

This day strong winds from the S.E. and clear weather on different tacks 3 sails in sight at sunset took in sail for the night. Middle part wind E. wore ship heading S. latter part the same. under all sail with pleasant weather & light winds 4 sails in sight. 50 fathoms water.
