This day fine weather & pleasant winds from the S. under full sail in different tacks. at 5 P.M. spoke the Griffiths 21 whaler this season. 65 fath. water. Middle part much the same. latter part light S. winds & clear weather in different tacks under full sail Two sails in sight

This day light winds from the S. & fine weather in various tacks nothing in sight in shape of whaler. Middle part much the same latter part light winds from the S. & fine weather as usual made all sail steering S.W. by W. Two sails in sight & in sight this day.

Middle part the same. latter part moderate winds from the S. & fine weather. Saw one whale lowered away in chase but did not strike. Employed hauling

Boat struck and killed the whale. at 12.30 brought the whale alongside
