Thursday November 10th

This day strong winds from the N.E. boats down Chasing
Whaler employed heeling. Aldashen's in sight. Whaling at
4 1/2 P.M. boats came along side whale going very quick
to the S.W. hauled on the line to the W. at 6 P.M. wind
calmed to the N.W. took in sail for the night. Even ship
heading N.E. Middle part wind to the N. heading N.E.
latter part moderate winds from the N. heading N.E. under
whale topsails at 9 A.M. finished heeling employed stowing
down Oil Nothing in sight

tacks under full sail. Nothing in sight 54 fathoms water. at
sunset shortened sail. Middle part light air & calm.
latter part moderate winds heading W under full sail
one sail in sight employed breaking out for Pipe Shoals
so ends this day.

Wednesday November 16th

This day moderate winds from the S.E. on different tacks
under whale sail. Watch employed breaking out one sail
in sight at sunset shortened sail for the night. middle
part the same. latter part at daylight set whale topsails
at 7 A.M. heavier squalls. Doubled up topsails & fueled
light sails blowing moderate hails from the S.E. on
different tacks

Thursday November 17th

This day began with a moderate hail from the S.E. under
double reefed topsails. four courses & main spencer. heading
East. Nothing in sight at 7 P.M. quite moderate. Middle
part much the same. latter part strong winds from the N.
and hazy weather under whale topsails & courses. steering
to the S.W. one sail in sight heeling 54 fathoms water

Friday November 18th

This day moderate hail from the N. steering S.W. under
topsails & 3 courses at 4 P.M. gave the S.W. back of the ship
at sunset shortened sail. 2 sails in sight. 54 fathoms water middle
part the same. latter part strong breeze from the N.E. clear. steering
S.W. under double reefed topsails one sail in sight 50 fathoms water
