

Remarks on board Bark Callao. South Atlantic
Friday December 16th

This day fine weather & light winds middle & latter parts much the same.

Saturday December 17th

This day moderate breeze from the N.W. & squalls attended watch on liberty at 9.0. AM. blowing heavy from the N.W. middle part much the same latter part light winds and variable.

Sunday December 18th

This day light winds & fine weather. middle & latter parts the same. at 9.0. AM. the Starboard Anchor & Cleared Chain.

Monday December 19th

This day strong N.W. winds & clear weather. Starboard watch watch on liberty. Middle & latter parts the same.

Tuesday December 20th

This day blowing strong from the N.W. by N. the latter parts the same. middle part more moderate. latter part moderate winds from the S.W. & fine weather.

Wednesday December 21st

This day begins with strong N.W. winds & clear weather. middle part the same. latter part light winds & fine weather.

Thursday December 22nd

This day begins with light N.W. winds & fine weather. middle & latter parts the same. at 9.0. AM. the Anchor.

Friday December 23rd

This day moderate winds from the W. & fine weather. middle part fine weather. latter part moderate & steady winds.

Saturday December 24th

This day blowing strong from the N.W. at 5.0. AM. the Starboard Anchor. middle part blowing quite fresh.

latter part moderate breeze from the W. & fine clear weather. at 9.0. AM. took the Starboard Anchor. & then short on the Starboard Anchor. at 9.0. AM. took the Starboard Anchor. & made sail steering out the Bay at 12.0. PM. passed the Headlands. steering N. by W. by W. under full sail. Drab Bantow went on shore with Captain & some of the crew on his account. and came on board about 4.0. PM. off duty.

Sunday December 25th

This day begins with light breeze from the W. & fine weather. under all sail at 9.0. AM. wind from the S.E. steering N. by W. by W. Middle part at 9.0. AM. at 1.0. PM. moderate breeze from the N.W. latter part strong winds from the N.W. on the 26th to the N.E. wind in the morning took us the S. by E. light sails & double reefed M. topsail & was ship heading W. by N. Drab Bantow still off duty.

Middle part wind from the N. latter part the same. heading N.E. by E. under full sail at 9.0. AM. was ship heading W. N.W. Drab Bantow off duty. No Observation.

Tuesday December 27th

This day begins with a moderate breeze from the N.W. & hazy weather on the wind heading W. under full sail at 9.0. AM. was ship heading N.E. by E. middle part the same. latter part moderate winds from the N.W. heading W. under full sail thick fog at 9.0. AM. sent a New fly fish. the Captain off duty.

Wednesday December 28th

This day moderate winds from the N.W. under all sail heading W. at 9.0. AM. was ship heading N.E. at 7.0. PM. in the light sails. thick fog middle & latter parts wind the same at 9.0. AM. was ship heading W. under full sail with thick fog. the Captain off duty.
