Thursday February 23rd

This day fine breeze from the ESE under easy sail
heading NE. employed boiling mudds but finished
boiling latter part fresh breeze from the ESE & foggy
at 10 AM clear weather nothing in sight Under easy sail
heading to the NE.

Friday February 24th

This day fresh breeze from the ESE & fine
clear weather Under double reefed topsails & mainsail
heading NE at 7 PM. was ship heading SSW. Mudds
but the same. Latter part moderate breeze from the ESE
& fine weather Under full sail to the SSW at 10 AM
saw a shoal of sperm whales at 10 AM. commenced chasing
the boats & gave chase

Saturday February 25th

This day fine breeze from the ESE & fine clear weather
Boats down chasing sperm whale at 4 O'Clock the boats
broke through the whale. at 6 PM. brought him
alongside at 7 the other boats came on board. one sail
in sight. shortened sail heading N. Mudds but
wind ESE. latter part the same at 5 AM. started
on to the whale & commenced cutting at 7 PM. finished
& made sail on the ship heading NE. at 10 PM
spoke the Barge Alho. of Fairhaven 3 miles Out to
Sperm.

Fresh part fresh breeze from the ESE Under double
sail heading NE. mudds employed. Clearing away
the heads at 4 PM. commenced boiling at 7 PM. was ship
to the SSW. latter part wind ESE & fine weather. Under
full sail employed boiling one sail in sight at 11 AM
finished boiling broke out salt provisions

Fresh part light & pleasant breeze from the ESE & fine
weather. Under full sail heading SE. the barge Alho
in sight at sunset took on sail for the night. Mudds
but the same. Latter part light breeze from the ESE &
fine weather employed showing down one sail in sight

Tuesday February 28th

This day fresh part light & pleasant winds from the ESE
heading SE. under easy sail at 2 PM. was ship heading
N. at 4 PM. finished stowing dis. at 10 PM. shortened sail
for the night. the barge Alho in sight Mudds but
the same. Latter part moderate winds from the ESE &
fine weather on the wind, to the NE. full sail. Mudds
employed in ship's duty

Fresh part light wind from the NE & fine weather Under
full sail heading NW. one sail in sight at 7
PM. was ship heading E & shortened sail. Mudds
but the same. Latter part made sail with a light breeze

at 11 PM. latter ship heading NW. watch employed in
various duties
