Monday, April 10<sup>th</sup>

This day, fine weather. Light wind. All recruits  
Watch busily employed getting water. Watch on shore.

Tuesday, April 11<sup>th</sup>

This day, fine weather. Carboard Watch on liberty.  
The other Watch busily employed getting board & water.

Wednesday, April 12<sup>th</sup>

This day, fine weather. Watch on liberty busily  
employed getting water & getting off recruits. Mr. Heath  
has been absent 48 hours. Another man by the name  
of Silas H. Sybil has been absent 48 hours.

Thursday, April 13<sup>th</sup>

This day, fine weather. Watch on liberty busily  
employed getting off recruits. Capt. Howland. Caught. Mr. Heath  
has brought him on board today. After an absence  
of 3 days. Carboard Watch on shore.

Friday, April 14<sup>th</sup>

This day, fine weather. Light wind. getting off  
recruits &c. Mr. Heath off duty. Caused by drunkenness.

Saturday, April 15<sup>th</sup>

This day, fine weather. Light wind from  
the N. & W. Ship ready for sea. Mr. Heath  
still off duty.

Sunday, April 16<sup>th</sup>

This day, light N.W. winds & fine weather.  
Mr. Heath off duty sick.

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Ocean Open, Whaling F. S. Henshaw. Master  
Monday, April 17<sup>th</sup>

First part. Moderate breeze. Fine weather. Middle part.  
Same. Latter part. Moderate breeze from the N.W. Took  
our anchor. & made sail & shot out the bay. &c.  
ends. Mr. H. Heath off duty sick.

Tuesday, April 18<sup>th</sup>

First part. Light & variable wind. employed working  
out the bay. at 1<sup>st</sup> P.M. strong breeze from the South.  
Doubly reefed the topsails. Heading E. at 3 P.M. by  
the headlands. at 4 P.M. in sight distant about  
20 miles. Middle part. The same. Latter part. Strong  
breeze from the South & heavy swell running. Heading  
E. under. Close reefed topsails & P. Conner. Mr. Heath  
off duty sick.

Wednesday, April 19<sup>th</sup>

First part. Strong breeze from the S. under. Close reefed  
topsails & P. Conner heading E. Middle part. The same.  
Latter part. more moderate from the S. & clear weather  
at. Whole topsails & P. Conner. Nothing in sight  
Mr. Heath still off duty sick.

Thursday, April 20<sup>th</sup>

First part. Moderate breeze from the S. & E. fine  
Heading E. & E. under. Whole topsails & P. Conner.  
Middle part. wind hauled to the E. braced the yards around

Heading to the S. E. under. Whole topsails & P. Conner. Mr. Heath  
still off duty.
