First part strong breeze from the S.W. with heavy rain squalls. steering N by E. under whale. lap sails & Conner. Middle part. single reefed the S.E. under heavy squalls. latter part strong breeze from the S.W. & fine clear weather steering N by E. under full sail at 4 P.M. saw the Island of Trinidad bearing N distant about 40 miles. Saw sail in sight steering to the N.E.
