In the name of God Amen This fifth day of March in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and twenty nine Thirty I John Cock of Kent County in the province of Maryland Taylor being very sick and weak of body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be given to God for the same therefor calling to' mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner following that is to say Principally I recommend my soul to God that gave it me and my body to be buried in a Christian like manner on George Vansants Dwelling Plantation at the descrition of my Executors hereafter named and as touching such worldly goods wherewith it please God to bless me I give and dispose the same in manner following Imp I will all my Just and lawful debts be fully discharges and paid by my Executor in some reasonable time after my decease Secondly I give bequeath unto George Humberston all the remainder of my goods Chattels rights and credits of any kind whatsoever after my Just debts are paid positively Willing and devising and so I do order it to be that the said George Humberston procure for John Vansant the son of George Vansant and render and deliver unto the said John when he shall arrive at the age of Seventeen years one good breeding mare two years old- Thirdly and Lastly I constitute ordain and appoint Mr. John Rogers to be the whole and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking disannuling and making void all other Wills or Will and Testaments by me heretofor made retifying and confirming this only to be my last will and testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year above written----John x Cock (Seal) signed sealed and published pronounced and declared to be his last will and Testement in the presence of us -- Jat Caulk Abel Stevens -- April 3rd 1730 Came Abel Stevens one of the subscribing Evidences to the within will and made oath upon the
