B. 7.20. Cloudy & rainy A.M. Clear P.M.

Would employ two men and
a boy more than I have.
Sent for Dr Blakistone to see
Geo. Lancaster. He came
late P.M.

Hugh Wright came down
to take leave of us this P.M.,
expecting to leave for At-
lanta Ga. to-morrow A.M.

Dr Blakistone sent for, & came
to see George Lancaster.

Jan 2nd 85 Very cold & clear, A.M.
Tended cow yard & hog pens
& shelled peas of cows. Stopped
sheeps from stable fields.

Have engaged for year, all the
hands I want.
