Sent same force to Waterloo, to sow wheat.

Sent to Waterloo 20 bushels wheat making 60 in all sent down.

Got in 2 more loads of turnips & trimmed off the tops - about 60 bushels of yellow globe - in all Carter & wife here to day.

Sowed about 16 bushels of wheat to day at Waterloo - in all at Waterloo, 44 bushels.
