Stone to act as Trustee to carry out the provisions herein made for the benefit of the children of my brother Z. D. Blakestone.

If the said Francis J. Stone should die, or decline to serve as guardian to my children, and as Trustee if the contingency named herein occur, I respectfully ask the Orphan's Court of the County, to appoint some suitable person to act in his stead; but ask and desire that they will not appoint any one who is related by consanguinity to either myself, or my husband John S. Lancaster.

I hereby appoint Francis J. Stone Executor of this my last will and testament.
