

November the xxixth MDCCLXV.

Laid out for Samuel Withers of this Province a parcell of land
called Withington lying in Talbot County on the north side of
Choptank River near to the head of a Creek called the second —
Creek Adjoyning to the land formerly laid out for John Hooper —
beginning at a marked Pine Tree standing upon a point by the
Creek side and running for breadth from the said Pine south and
by west one hundred Perches, bounded on the West by a line —
Drawn East and by north for length three hundred and twenty
Perches, on the North by a line Drawn North and by East —
from the end of the East and by north line, One hundred —
Perches, untill it intersect a parallel with the said Creek
on the East by the said Creek or parallel on the South by the
first south and by west line, Continuing and now laid out for
Two hundred acres more or less, To be held of the mannor of
Baltimore.
