State, in pursuance of the provisions of
the act of 1833 c 224. and 1845 c 105, the
Court having considered the Petition, and
being satisfied by competent testimony, do
this 22 day of April 1853. order and
adjudge, that the said Richard Hutchins
do and he is hereby authorized to sell the
said slave Matilda, out of the State, for the
highest price for term of years, to wit, for
which will be paid, on the 24 day
of March, in the year Eighteen hundred
and seventy six
