Gentlemen of the First Branch of the City Council.

I have approved & signed the following Ordinances which originated in your Branch to wit: An Ordinance to carry into effect an act of the General Assembly of Maryland entitled an act for erecting a Lazaretto on the waters of the Patuxent for the reception of persons infected with malignant contagious disorders. An Ordinance for the more effectual filling up of Charles Street from Pratt Street to Barré Street a Supplement to the Ordinance for the regulating the sweeping of chimneys. An Ordinance directing the manner of filling up footways for the preservation of the Road Stairs and Street pavements. An Ordinance for the raising and repaving Liberty Street. An additional Supplement to an Ordinance entitled an Ordinance to regulate the inspection of Lumber. An Ordinance for the better security

of the Magazines by building a brick wall or a fence and erecting a barrier for the Superintendent, An Ordinance for repairing the end of the Publick Dock between South Street and Commerce Street, an Ordinance for the filling up and paving between Street from Lexington Street to German Street.
