of the Mayor, beg leave to report.

That your Committee have
taken the said communication into consid-
eration and are of opinion that the subjects
therein recommended to the attention of the
City Council should be referred to Committees
to be appointed by each Branch to report thereon
by bill or otherwise - Your Committee there-
fore propose that the following subjects be
referred to Committees to be appointed by
the First Branch, to wit:

1. . . . 1st Inspection Laws.
2. . . . 2nd The ordinances to restrain gaming and to
license and regulate theatrical and other public
exhibitions.
3. . . . 3rd The ordinance regulating the sale of Bread.
4. . . . 4th Sinking of wells and repairing Pumps.
5. . . . 5th Acts of the Legislature respecting Lotteries.

The following subjects to be referred to Com-
mittees to be appointed by the Second
Branch.

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- 1st The Deepening and clearing the Harbour.
 - 2nd Supplying the City with water from Springs
or fountains.
 - 3rd Alterations in the Charter of Incorporation
proposed in the Legislature of the State.
 - 4th Revision of the Health Laws.

Your Committee recommend the following
resolution to wit:

Resolved, that the communication
of the Mayor to the City Council at the com-
mencement of the present Session be published
in the several newspapers published in this
City.
