

An ordinance for the inspection of Hogs
Lard in the City of Baltimore was received
from the Second Branch read a first
time and ordered to lie on the table.

The ordinance appropriating a sum money
for the pavement of the public part
of the Street on the west side of the
Docks South of market space and
directing the City Commissioners to issue
~~their~~ their warrants for collecting a
private tax thereon was recommended to
the Committee by whom it was reported.

The additional Supplement to the ordinance
