The ordinance to regulate the inspection of
hogg lands in the City of Baltimore was
read a second time and will pass and
thereupon transmitted to the Second Branch.

The ordinance to regulate the anchorage of
of vessels in the harbor of Baltimore was
returned by the Second Branch passed
with amendments.

Some of which amendments being disagreed
to a Message was sent to the Second
Branch requesting the appointment
of a Committee of conference and
Mess^{rs} Tenant and Williams were appointed
on the part of the first Branch.

The further Supplement to the ordinance to
regulate the cording of fire wood within
the City of Baltimore was read a second time
and will pass and was thereupon transmitted
to the Second Branch.
