The Petition of John Martin and others was read and ordered to lie on the table

The further Supplement to the ordinance entitled an ordinance for regulating auctions within the City of Baltimore and precincts thereof was received from the second Branch not passed.

The ordinance to impose a tax on the real and personal property within the City of Baltimore and to provide for the collection of the same was read and ordered to lie on the table
