On leave given an ordinance to encourage the planting of trees on the sides of the Streets in the City of Baltimore and for the protection of the same was read a first time and by special order a second time and passed and thereupon transmitted to the second branch and by them returned passed.

The following resolve was transmitted to the Second Branch

Resolved by the first and second branches of the City Council of Baltimore that two hundred copies of the ordinance to regulate the inspection of Lumber and the ordinance to regulate the inspection of Staves and headings be printed and placed in the hands of such persons as will be most likely to circulate them through the country whence such lumber staves and headings are brought
