Resolved by the 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Branches of the City Council that the sum of three hundred and sixty eight dollars and fifty four cents be appropriated in the ordinance making appropriations for the year 1804. to discharge a balance due Joshua Innis on account of repairs of gutters in the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Wards. which resolution was read and ordered to lie on the table.

On motion Messrs Jencant and Buchanan were appointed a committee to enquire into the merits of the claim of the said Joshua

Innis and to report thereon for the information of the Branch

The Resolution for including in the Bill making appropriations for the year 1804. the sum of one hundred Dollars to enable the Mayor to rent a house for the Superintendent of the Powder Magazine ~~which~~ was read and agreed to and thereupon transmitted to the Second Branch.

The Committee appointed on the Petitions of Mr Proctor and others and Joshua Ambler and others reported a bill entitled A Supplement to an ordinance entitled an ordinance for building an additional Market house in the eighth Ward which was read a first and by special order a second time and passed

On motion the Branch adjourned until tomorrow afternoon at 3 o'clock.
