Tenant and Schaeffer in answer to which the same Branch returned a Message stating the appointment of Messrs. Johnston and Payson for the purpose aforesaid.

The Committee on the Petition of John O'Donnell report a bill entitled an Ordinance for the Introduction of water into the City of Baltimore which was read and by special order read a second time and will pass and was thereupon transmitted to the Second Branch and by them returned passed.
