On motion therefor the bill entitled an Ordinance for the more effectual prevention and extinguishment of fires within the City of Baltimore, was re-committed to the Committee by whom it was reported.

The Bill entitled an Ordinance for the more effectual inspection of herrings and other fish was received from the second Branch

The following Message was received from the Second Branch,

Gentlemen of the 1st Branch,

We do not concur in your amendment to the bill entitled an Ordinance respecting the night watch &c and propose the appointment of a Committee of conference and have appointed Mr. Payson and Mr. Fife the Committee on the part of the Second Branch.

In answer to which the Second Branch were informed that the first Branch had appointed Messrs Kell Senaut and Moore for the purpose in their Message mentioned.

On motion Messrs Kell and Buchanan were appointed a Committee on the part of the first Branch to join the members to be appointed by the Second Branch to report rules and regulations on the intercourse and communications between the two branches.
