The Memorial of the several fire Companies was
read and referred to Messrs. Jessop Kell & Thrum.

A message was transmitted to the Second Branch
informing them that the first Branch had
appointed Messrs. Kell and Buchanan
to join the member to be appointed by the
Second Branch to report rules for the
government of the intercourse and
communications between the two
Branches.

The Report of the Committee on the Petition of
Christopher Hughes and the Communi-
-cation of the Mayor respecting John &
Howard Inquire &c. was read a second
time and concurred with.

A message was received from the Second Branch
stating the appointment of Mr. Payson to
join Messrs. Kell and Buchanan to report
rules for the government of the intercourse
and communications between the two Branches.

An additional Supplement to the ordinance¹⁶⁵
entitled an ordinance for the inspection
of salted provisions &c. was read a second
time and will not pass.

The following resolution was read and adopted
in the first Branch and thereupon trans-
-mitted to the Second Branch viz.

Resolved by the first and second branches
of the City Council that there be included
in the ordinance making appropriations
for the year 1805, the sum of five hundred
and fifty dollars to be paid to John Howard
Esq. upon his releasing this Corporation
from all claim which he may have
thereon for the filling up and wharfing
a part of Barré Street, and a sum of
one hundred dollars, to be paid to Chris-
-toper Hughes Inquire upon the like terms
and also the sum of one hundred dollars
to be expended in the completion of the
filling up of Cambden Street under the
direction of the former Commissioners.

which resolution was returned by the Second
Branch agreed to with an amendment, and
on reading the amendment it was con-
-curred with by the first branch.
